





Musical statues

greater body control when forming statues.

> Encourage players to hold the body position for different lengths of time. > Slow down the pace of the music to allow

> Players form groups of three

and form a statue together.



Players dance freely around the room. When the music stops, players must freeze and form a statue.

What you need

> Music player and music

What to do

- > The music starts and players dance freely around the room.
- > When the music stops, players must freeze and form a statue (eg: tree, stork, airplane).
- > Players discuss different statues and choose a favourite one.

> Players repeat and copy a statue from another player in the room the next time the music stops.

Scoring

> Points are awarded for

- the most creative statues.
- > Not scoring is an option.

Ask the players


> Check there is enough
